This is a second CD of the Spohr's chamber music for violin and harp. Arparla first CD is the only CD of Spohr's music on original instruments (actually now there is a CD of Spohr's nonet come out, or coming out).

Allegro – Larghetto - Rondo

This will not be ALL Spohr's harp music because we can't fit all on 2 CDs. Naxos put everything except his Variations Op 36 for solo harp on 2 Cds. We didn't plana second CD when we recorded the first, so for example we only recorded the 2 movt of Op. 114 (potpuorri on Mozart Themes) because the first movt was very similar to op.113 which we did record in full.

Our proposal is to record the above 3 pieces and that's Spohr for our lifetime!

Davide is the only person in the world who plays with a Spohr chinrest that he made himself.

Op. 115, 16 & 118 are all new for us so we need some concerts before recording. WoO23 we've played a few times and is easy. Op. 16 is easy too.
